- We offer our clients advice on the recognition process: we explain to them the recognition procedure and assist them with their search for the adequate competent authority for the recognition procedure.
- We offer free of charge consultation by phone, email or in person. However face-to-face appointments should be reserved in advance whether by phone or email.
- We require for our counselling service the following documents, (if available) degrees and diplomas (preferably translated in German), curriculum vitae, work experience certificates as well as reply letters from the competent authority.
- We offer professional training to staff members of statutory offices and institutions involved in the recognition of foreign degrees/credentials.
